

Speyside Distillery Casks available, priced between £2,310 and £3,231.36.



Winners of the 2021 Single Cask of the Year, Speyside Distillery Co are an enthusiast-focused distillery who came on stream in the 90s and are known for a grassy, slightly citrusy Whisky which is increasingly attracting the attention of Independent Bottlers. Having signed a large distribution deal in China and the associated territories in 2019 the Stills are being moved to a new site by 2025 which will render the original a 'Closed Distillery' under SWA Regulations.

Offered as New-Make Spirit (Filled Q4 2022) these Casks are best suited to longer hold periods and cannot be moved or sold for the first 3 years. 5 Years complimentary storage and insurance are included, and the Casks obtain full, automatic Distillery Naming Rights at the age of 15.

Two Cask Types are presently available. 1st-fill Grand Cru Casks have previously held Grand Cru Wine before being filled with Scotch Whisky for the first time and this provenance can be stated on the label. Wine Casks add Tanic notes to the Whisky and often produce a drier finish. Previously an unusual style, Wine Casks are increasing in popularity amongst enthusiasts and this 'niche within a niche' is expected to grow further. These Casks are priced between £2,310 and £2,425.50 depending on the fill-level.

The traditional Sherry Cask remains both popular and scarce in the current market and will always be prized for its rich fruit flavours and beautiful dark colour – especially important in the Asian market. 1st-fill Oloroso Casks can include the type of Sherry held on the label and are priced between £3,168.00 and £3,231.36 depending on fill level.
